WAYS AND MEANS

1. Serve on CDE committees

3. Dress code to be enforced at dances, motels, activities, etc. Dress code and release form?

3. Each chapter should have at least one applicant for a state level scholarship.
4. Provide a \$500 scholarship to student (junior) majoring in ag education at USU.
1. Officers and instructors to take the lead.
2. Advisors instruct members on the proper use of the jacket.
3. Have FFA leaders enforce regulations.
4. Official dress be worn to and from the national convention.
5. Help enforce on stage at awards, etc.
1. Send letters to parents and school administrators
2. Be involved in school awards program.
3. Send letters to legislators (local and state).
4. Promote FFA activities
5. Communicate with counselors.
6. Work with community leaders.
