### WAYS AND MEANS

1. Each Area Chair is an ex-officio member of this committee and will work with individuals in his/her area in the collection of dues.
  2. Association Dues Remitter to meet with committee members and area chairs to make final drive for collection of dues.

1. Have Membership Committee nominate honorary members of the NAAE.
- 
1. Membership Committee reviews nomination to be presented to the group for approval.
- 
1. Present 10-, 20-, and 30-year pins for years of service.
  2. Present Certificate of Distinguished Service to members who terminate Vo-Ag teaching after at least ten years.
  3. Present a blanket and Distinguished Service Certificate for the FFA Supply Service upon retirement from teaching Vo-Ag for at least 20 years.
  4. Present a watch to teachers at retirement. Find a sponsor, such as UAAE.
